

POA Board Update:

We appreciate the ongoing patience and support from everyone as we continue to work through the issues surrounding the fencing/wall project that has always remained front and center for your POA board. As stated previously, that although the board intends to address all of the fencing concerns in due time, the primary focus for discussion is currently that of Cypress North Houston. Admittedly, the information gathering process had unexpectedly slowed a bit as we continued to communicate with and then must wait on responses from multiple third parties. Rest assured, however, that we want nothing more than to be able to present everyone with specific information and the options to vote on in an open and forthright manner as soon as possible, and we are confident that at that time everyone will recognize that the board has not been sitting back and procrastinating on the issue. Please understand that we will not rush through what has begun only to end up sharing poor or wrong information. We wish we could share tidbits thus far, but since this has proven to be such a polarizing subject and the details remain quite fluid, the board feels it is appropriate to simply wait until we are ready to present everything in its entirety, thus minimizing the unnecessary distractions and false conclusions that would ultimately ensue from not having all of the details. Therefore, we will continue to work tirelessly and take the time necessary to present the information properly because we are not interested in wasting anyone's time. When that time comes, the board intends to schedule the presentation in a Town Hall format, hopefully to be held at Warner Elementary School where there should be more space for everyone since turnout is expected to be high. Then on another day a short time later our official board meeting will be scheduled, again hopefully to be held at Warner Elementary, whereby a community vote on the presented options can take place from residents of Phase 1 and 2.

We will also post the notification on the board's new website, and intend to also install yard signs at the entrance roads to the Phase 1 and 2 areas to further supplement community awareness for these meetings.
